**At the Beacon, we recognise each child as an individual, and aim to give all children every opportunity to realise their full potential. We therefore ask all parents/carers and pupils to sign up to our Home/School agreement.**

Parents / carers are always welcome to visit the school and an active partnership is encouraged. Links with parents are vitally important in the development of The Beacon pupils. These links are encouraged in many different ways, through formal and informal channels. Parents are initially invited to the school when their child is going to be offered a place and will be given a prospectus and admission pack to complete. The annual review of a child's EHCP meeting is the most formal meeting of the year where parents are invited to meet with their child's class teacher, discuss the written report and set targets for the coming year. Outside agencies are invited to attend this meeting.
