

Term 1 – Learning in Wingham Class

Themed Learning:

This term, we are reading:

'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'



Basic Learner Skills:

This area focuses on helping children develop early communication, engagement and focus skills.

This term, we will continue to develop these skills through themed Attention Autism (Bucket) sessions that human senses such as sight and hearing.

Academic Skills:

This category develops further skills in the areas of Literacy through phonics, recognising, matching and reading letters/words/sentences, writing and spelling. Numeracy through number work - sequencing, counting, adding, subtracting, money, and time.

Pupils have their own individualised academic skills they will be developing during their daily learning box sessions.

We're Going on a Bear Hunt will be our weekly sensory story for the term as this links with our topic of human senses. Regular repetition helps to develop vocabulary, reading and a range of communication skills.

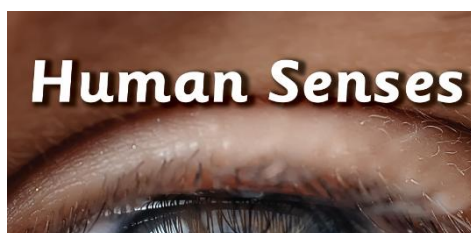
Motor Skills:

This category develops imitation skills, hand-eye coordination, hand and grip development for writing, as well as balance, coordination and core strength.

In PE, we will be developing awareness of our senses by moving to a range of music.

In Music, we will practice imitation skills by engaging with songs that link to our bodies and senses.

In Art, we will continue to develop a range of fine motor skills through process focused art activities that reflect the season and our story.



Self-help skills:

This category develops routines and independence in personal hygiene, eating, self-care and toileting.

In cooking, we will be exploring food/ingredients using all our senses.
