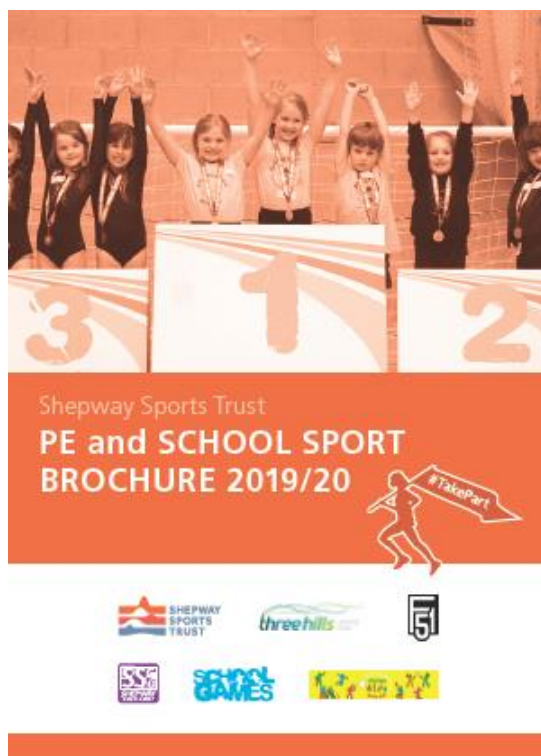

4 Essentials to do on Yourschoolgames.org if you want to achieve your School Games Mark this year

1. Register your school and a teacher on yourschoolgames.com-

Go to www.yourschoolgames.com and log in using your username and password. If you do not have a log in already then scroll down to the bottom of the screen and write your school name in the 'Find your School' area.

Then register a teacher on your account. To do this go to 'Your School' at the top and look at the 'Your School Users' box.

2. Add your school games day date/ sports day date (Log in, Go to 'Events' at the top of the page, scroll to the very bottom of the page and click on 'Add a Sports competition that you have run in school', complete the answers on the page, ensure you click 'Yes' when it asks you if it is a School Games Day' then publish at the end).

3. Register on the Active Schools Planner (click on this on your dashboard)

4. Complete your 'Inclusive Health Check' (scroll down on your dashboard to the bottom of the page and click on the Inclusive Health Check).

Congratulations to Lympne Primary School who upgraded their School Games Mark from Bronze last year to Gold this year.

If you are aiming for Silver or Gold School Games Mark you must complete one heatmap at www.activeschoolsplanner.com

Here's how to do this....1. Sign up to the Active School Planner and login.



2. Click on 'Help Videos'

Scroll down to 'Create a new heatmap' and follow the instructions on the 6 minute video to create your own heatmap.

Please find attached a guidance document which gives you an explanation and examples of supporting evidence for every prerequisite and every criteria of the Gold, Silver and Bronze awards.

BRONZE CRITERIA			
Increasing Engagement In School Games			
Criterion	Explanation	Examples of Supporting Evidence	Comments
Plans in place to provide all students with two hours of Physical Education, school sport and physical activity per week inclusive of extra curriculum provision. <i>Applicable to Years 3-11 only.</i>	All schools should ensure that students have access to a high-quality PE experience. Within this, schools should be aspiring to two hours of curriculum provision. The school should be able to evidence that they have planned intentions to deliver two hours of PE per week in the future. This could include, through consultation with young people, the review of termly extracurricular sport and physical activity opportunities inclusive of before school, lunchtime and after school. Special Schools For some young people, this will be inclusive of physical therapy sessions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School timetable • Governors' minutes • PE/school longer-term plans/strategies 	<i>This criterion applies to Years 3-11 but does NOT apply to Years 12 and 13.</i>
Engage at least 20% of pupils (5% for special schools/PRUs) in extracurricular sporting and physical activity every week. <i>Applicable to Years 3-11 only.</i>	Extracurricular activity is any sporting/physical activity that takes place above and beyond the curriculum. This includes before school, lunchtime and after school hours. This provision can be wider than the School Games sports formats and includes engagement in organised physical activity.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registers of young people taking part • Extracurricular programme of activity • Promotional material regarding activity 	<p>The percentage calculation is based on the number of spaces taken up within extracurricular activity, and not individual students. Example: if you have 160 young people attending sessions per week and 500 students on your school roll (Y3-11), then $160 \div 500 \times 100 = 32\%$.</p> <p>When trying to calculate the 'average' engaged in extracurricular activity it is recommended to take the same week for each of the three school terms (i.e. say week four of autumn, spring and summer) and look at the numbers engaged in activity during those weeks. Then add the three figures together and divide by three to give an average in terms of numbers engaged in activity.</p>

Awards Definitions

School Games Star of the Year

School Games Team of the Year

These awards aim to recognise an outstanding individual or team from those competing in Shepway School Games during 2018/19. Nominees must be between the ages of 7-18 to be eligible for this award.
