

KS4 Entry Level English Overview

In Entry Level English learners will develop the skills to read and understand non-fiction and literary texts. They will develop the skills to be able to demonstrate an appropriate control of Standard English and to write grammatically correct sentences. Entry Level English builds confidence and is designed to be accessible and relevant, providing students with recognition for their achievements.

Throughout the course learners will:

- read a range of texts with some understanding
- use knowledge gained from reading to inform their own writing
- write using Standard English appropriately
- use grammar correctly, punctuate and spell accurately
- acquire an appropriate vocabulary in reading, writing and spoken language
- understand and respond to spoken language and use spoken Standard English where appropriate

On completion of the course students will achieve an Entry Level 1, 2 or 3 qualification in English.
