The very large majority of pupils are making expected or better progress by the end year 6 in English, Maths and across most other subject areas. Large cohorts of this year group made good or better progress in English (72%) and Maths (80%). Science (96%)

By the end of year 6 nearly all students are on track to make expected and above expected progress in English (92%), Maths (96%) and Science (100%). The large majority making well above expected progress from their starting points.

In English 18 pupils, 72% are making accelerated progress (Good plus Outstanding)

In Reading 14 pupils, 58% are making accelerated progress (Good plus Outstanding)

In Maths 20 pupils, 80% are making accelerated progress (Good plus Outstanding)

In Science 24 pupils, 96% are making accelerated progress (Good plus Outstanding)
